Information for people who have to register (persons subject to registration)

1. **When do I have to register or deregister?**
 - If you are moving into a new apartment, you must register within **3 days**.
 - If you move out, you must **deregister at least 3 days before or after you move out**.
2. **What do I need to register?**
 - **Official documents**, for example:
 - Passport or birth certificate
 - Documents with your name, date of birth, place of birth and nationality
 - If you **are not an Austrian citizen**: passport
 - If you move and the new apartment becomes your main residence, you must also deregister the old main residence.
3. **Who is responsible for the form (registration form)?**
 - It doesn't matter who fills out the form. The important thing is that the resident is responsible.
 - Please check the registration form carefully before submitting it.
4. **What is the main residence?**
 - This is the place where you mainly want to live.
 - There you are registered, for example, in elections, receive important mail and can register your car.
 - If you live in several places, the place where you spend most of your time counts.
5. **What is important when moving?**
 - If you change your main residence or get a new secondary residence, you must also inform other authorities, e.g. for car registration.
6. **Gender entry in the population register:**
 - Your gender is listed in the population register.
 - There is also the option to choose "inter", "diverse", "open" or "not specified" if you do not clearly see yourself as male or female.
7. **Information on religion or church:**
 - If you belong to a legally recognized church or religion, they may receive your data.
 - But you don't have to specify this if you don't want to.
 - Only recognized churches or religions may receive your data.

Note for EEA citizens and Swiss nationals:

- If you are from an EU country, Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein or Switzerland:
 - You must report **to the Foreigners' Registration Office within 4 months of entering Austria at the latest if you are staying for more than 3 months**.
 - This message is called a **registration certificate**.
