

How do I separate my rubbish correctly?

Residual waste



What belongs here?

- Sweepings
- Nappies / diapers
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Yoghurt cups, beverage cans (will be sorted out automatically)
- Plastic bags
- Ballpoint pens
- Dog excrement and cat litter (in a bag)

Organic waste



What belongs here?

- Spoiled foodstuffs
- Food waste
- Coffee grounds, tea bags
- Paper tissues
- Fruit peelings & scraps
- Eggshells
- Leaves, grass clippings

Waste paper



What belongs here?

- Newspapers
- Magazines, brochures, catalogues without packing foil
- Exercise books and sheets of paper
- Paper bags
- Packing paper
- Small boxes
- No ring binders

Plastic *plastic bottles, beverage cartons*



What belongs here?

- PET bottles (please crush)
- Plastic bottles for ketchup and cosmetic products
- Beverage cartons
- No plastic foil, plastic cups or fruit cartons

Glass



What belongs here?

- Beverage bottles made of glass (except deposit bottles)
- Empty glass bottles for cosmetics or food (e.g. oil bottles)
- Pickle and jam jars
- No lamps
- No flat glass

Hazardous waste



What?

- Paints, varnishes
- Cleaning agents
- Cosmetics

Old electrical devices

- Television and computer screens
- Electrical appliances (big, small)
- Cooling units
- Fluorescent tubes, energy-saving bulbs
- Batteries

Waste materials

- Kitchen oil
- Cartridges from copy machines
- CDs, DVDs and CD-Roms
- Bottle corks
- Corrugated cardboard



All these go to the recycling centre

■ **Separating rubbish is good, makes sense, saves money and is a legal duty (§ 12 SAWG)**

■ **Collection containers for paper, glass, electrical devices, organic waste, oil are available at the recycling centre**
